Top tips for new drivers

- Find out the location of the chargers you'll use most often **in advance**
- Get into the habit of charging little and often
- Spend some time **pre planning your route** before you leave
- Have a Plan A, Plan B, and Plan C for all journeys
- Focus on **looking at the percentage, not the mileage**



Do's and don'ts for new drivers

- **Don't** top up to 100% after every short drive
- **Don't** hog charger bays
- **Do** as other EV drivers for help if you need it
- **Do** plan your route with contingency mileage
- **Do** think about your journey in advance
