#### Top tips for new drivers

- Find out the <u>location of the chargers</u> you'll use most often **in advance**
- Get into the habit of charging little and often

- Focus on looking at the percentage, not the mileage

- Try not to block a charger -When you're done, move on

- Try to juice up no more than 80%
- · Never unplug another car



### Do's and don'ts for new drivers

- **Don't** top up to 100% after every short drive
- Don't hog charger bays
- Do as other EV drivers for help if you need it
- **Do** plan your route with contingency mileage
- Do think about your journey in advance
